*Improved Access to Information:* This latest release also includes the ability to query on additional data elements from the Medication Administration Record, working diagnosis, and active orders display.

*Improved Reporting:* The new functionality allows hospitals administrators to run customized summary reports for each forms category, making it easy to report on clinical activity and associated costs.
